Who deserves a Shining Star?


We award Shining Stars to volunteers and groups of volunteers whose outstanding service and achievements exemplify the positive impact we always strive to make within our MS communities.

Here are some examples of volunteer service we award Shining Stars for:

- Making a significant difference to people living with MS
- Successfully recruiting and supporting other volunteers
- Leading or supporting an MS Society group through a challenging time
- Extraordinary fundraising

- Implementing an impactful new service, improving the quality of existing services, or delivering an exceptional quality service in a group
- Successfully leading or supporting a local or national campaign
- Introducing innovative ways of fundraising, campaigning or providing services

Submitting a Shining Star nomination

You can submit a Shining Star nomination in these ways:

Online Nomination Form

The easiest way to submit your Shining Star nomination is to click on this link - Online Nomination Form. You'll receive an automatic response to let you know we've received your nomination.

Paper Nomination Form

Alternatively, you can print a copy of our <u>Paper Nomination Form</u> or ask our Volunteering Team to send you one. Complete it and post it to:

Individual and group nominations

You can use either of our forms to submit a Shining Star nomination for an individual volunteer, or an outstanding group project.

You can nominate up to 10 volunteers for a group Shining Star award on our nomination forms. If your group nomination is approved, each nominated volunteer will receive a Shining Star lapel pin and a certificate.

If you need to nominate more than 10 volunteers for a group Shining Star, please contact our Volunteering Team.

What should we include on our nomination form?

Both versions of our nomination form ask you to tell us what makes the volunteer or group of volunteers worthy of a Shining Star. Make sure you answer all the questions and give as much detail as you can.

If you submit an incomplete nomination form, we may need to contact you for more information before it can be considered by the Shining Star Panel.

Shining Star Panel

Our Shining Star Panel meets every two months to consider Shining Star nominations. The panel is formed by members of our National Councils and Board of Trustees.

Our Volunteering Team will contact you to confirm when your nomination is due to be considered by the Shining Star Panel.

We only accept Shining Star nominations for volunteers or groups of volunteers who hold one of our approved roles and are registered on our volunteer database.

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
